On April 12, 2012, Ohio EPA received a response letter to Ohio EPA's letter dated March 30, 2012. Based on Ohio EPA's review of this letter, USDOE and Fluor-B&W have adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations cited in the February 16, 2012 Notice of Violation letter. The violations were cited as a result of the January 3, 2012 overflow of contaminated groundwater at the X-749 Equalization (EQ) Tank.

It is Ohio EPA's expectation that should an incident occur at the facility meeting the situations described in the contingency plan or an incident similar to the January 3, 2012 release, that the contingency plan will be implemented and followed as approved.
