Subject: Notice of Violation - Failure to provide adequate treatment of a surface water source.

Dear Ms. Petrachkoff:

The Village of Lisbon public water system is in violation of Ohio Revised Code chapter 6109 by failing to comply with the requirements for disinfection of surface water pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-81-72.

The Village of Lisbon public water system could not determine that sufficient disinfection treatment of its drinking water occurred February 8, 2010, when chlorine feed and monitoring equipment failed. The chlorine feed was interrupted for a considerable but unknown amount of time. Also the continuous chlorine monitoring equipment failed at some time during the day.

Failure to meet any requirement of OAC 3745-81-72 is a treatment technique violation in accordance to OAC 3745-81-72 (B) for which public notification is required. The public notice shall be conducted in accordance with OAC 3745-32 (C) and shall be provided as soon as practical but no later than 30 days after the public water system learns of the violation. Community water systems shall provide notice using the following forms of delivery in order to reach all persons served:


- a) Mail of direct delivery to each customer receiving a water bill and to other service connections to which water is delivered by the public water system; and
- b) Any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons regularly served by the system, otherwise not receiving the notice required in (a). Such persons may include those who do not pay water bills such as renters, inmates, residents of nursing homes etc. Other acceptable methods of issuance may include publication in a local newspaper, and posting on the internet and delivery to community organization. If the notice is posted, it must be posted for a minimum of seven (7) days.

The required public notice is included with this correspondence. The public notice must be issued as shown. Any modification to the public notice must be approved by the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office prior to issuance. A copy of both the public notice (as issued) and the completed verification form must be returned to the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office at the letterhead address within ten (10) days after issuing the notice.
