SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOR FAILURE TO SUBMIT A CORROSION CONTROL RECOMMENDATION

Dear Board Member:

This letter is notification that the Village of South Amherst water system is in violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) for failure to submit a Corrosion Control Recommendation for corrosion control equipment as specified in OAC rules 3745-81-80 through 3745-81-89.

In order to avoid any further violations, you must complete the following:

By **June 30, 2010**, you will need to submit a corrosion control recommendation (CCT) to this office.

By **November 29, 2010**, you should have delivered the public education materials by the following means:

- Mail or other direct delivery to each customer; and
- Any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons regularly served by the system.

Enclosed is information containing the required wording for these public education materials and a verification form. Please complete the verification form and return it to this office with a copy of the informational notice. Public education must be distributed every 12 months as long as the water system exceeds the lead action level. If you have completed lead and copper monitoring for this six-month monitoring period, please notify me as soon as possible.
