Subject: Notice of Violation of failure to issue public education materials for lead action level exceedance

Dear Mr. Warino:

A review of our records indicates that your public water system incurred a violation of rule 3745-81-85 (C)(2) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) for failure to distribute lead public education information on lead in drinking water to each person served by the Jackson Milton Service Area water system by November 29, 2008. The delivery of public education material is required whenever a public water system exceeds the lead action level. Please refer to our letter of December 2, 2008, enclosed. Your public water system exceeded the lead action level during the sampling period of June - September 2008.

Please note that you are still required to distribute the lead public educational materials within 30 days of receipt of this letter and submit verification of distribution to this office not more than 10 days after distribution. Public education must be distributed every 12 months as long as the water system exceeds the lead action level.

Actions required as a result of the above violation

Step 1	<p>Within 30 days issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following method(s) to reach all persons served by the public water system:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections to which water is delivered; and 2. Any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons regularly served by the system (e.g. publication in a local newspaper, delivery of multiple copies for distribution by customers that provide their drinking water to others, posting in public places served by the system or on the Internet, or delivery to community organizations).

Step 2	Fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued within 10 days to the Northeast District Office of the Ohio EPA.
Step 3	Within 30 days provide the appropriate lead exceedance public education as required by letter dated December 2, 2008.
Step 4	Fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public education materials issued within 10 days to the Northeast District Office of the Ohio EPA.
