Subject: Failure to Sample Drinking Water for Total Coliforms as Required

Dear Sir/Madam:

Andis Convenience Store PWS is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for failure to comply with the total coliform monitoring.

Monitoring Period: July 2008
Required Coliform Monitoring: 5 routines the month following a routine positive
Sample Results Submitted: One

To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system monitoring for total coliforms is essential.

ACTION REQUIRED:

- 1. Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served.


Transient or Non Transient Non Community	
Timing:	As soon as practical, but no later than 30 days after learning of the violation:
Methods:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Posting in conspicuous location, such as bulletin boards, restrooms, drinking fountains, vending areas • Mail or other direct delivery to each customer • Newsletters or newspaper • E-mail to employees or students • Send to parents or guardians of children at schools or day care facilities
Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.	

2. **Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to Ohio EPA - Northeast District Office. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published or posted.
3. During July 2008, total coliform samples have been collected, but none of these were the **required five routine total coliform samples**. Note that this system still remains on a boil advisory. To remove the boil advisory four negative repeat samples collected on the same day must be analyzed by a State certified lab and the results submitted to this office.
4. This office has been leaving messages for you intermittently for the last two months, but has yet to speak with you to discuss this serious situation. **Contact me immediately to discuss how best to troubleshoot your system and schedule a site visit to review how to return to compliance.**

If total coliform samples were collected as required, submit the results as soon as possible. The monitoring violation would be rescinded and a reporting violation given for late submittal of the results.
