**Subject: Notice of Violation - Failure to Sample Drinking Water as Required for Total Coliforms**

Dear Owner/Operator:

Your public water system is in violation of Rule 3745-81-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the coliform monitoring requirements:

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	<b>January - March 2007</b>
<b>Required Coliform Sampling:</b>	<b>One /Calendar Quarter</b>
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	<b>None</b>

#### Actions required as a result of the above violation

Step 1	<p><b>Within 30 days</b> issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Continuous posting, mail, or other direct delivery; and</li> <li>2. If necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons served by the public water system.</li> </ol> <p><i>The language in italic on the attached public notice is mandatory language and must be included as written.</i></p>
Step 2	<p>Within ten (10) days of completing <b>Step 1</b> above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the District Office of the Ohio EPA.</p>



If samples were taken, we have not received the results. Please forward a copy of the results to my attention. Late reporting is a reporting violation but if the sample was taken and a result obtained, you will not need to issue the attached public notice.

**NOTE: This is the second consecutive quarterly bacteria violation for this system. Please be aware that chronic violations may lead to escalated enforcement actions.**
