Subject: Notice of Violation - Failure to Sample Drinking Water as Required for Total Coliforms. NOTE: This system remains on a Boil Advisory.

Dear Sir/Madam:

Your public water system is in violation of Rule 3745-81-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the coliform monitoring requirements:

Monitoring Period:	November 2007
Required Coliform Sampling:	At least 5 in the month after a coliform-positive
Sample Results Submitted:	None


Actions required as a result of the above violation	
Step 1	<p>Within 30 days issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Continuous posting, mail, or other direct delivery; and If necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons served by the public water system. <p><i>The language in italic on the attached public notice is mandatory language and must be included as written.</i></p>
Step 2	<p>Within ten (10) days of completing Step 1 above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the District Office of the Ohio EPA.</p>

Step 3	Lifting the Boil Advisory - The public notice water use advisory shall remain in effect until one complete set of four (4) repeat total coliform-negative samples, collected on the same day (contain no coliforms). Clearly mark each repeat sample slip as "repeat sample." It is advisable to notify your customers when the problem has been corrected.
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Note: If samples were taken, we have not received the results. Please forward a copy of the results to my attention. Late reporting is a reporting violation but if the sample was taken and a result obtained, you will not need to issue the attached public notice.
