**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION - FAILURE TO SAMPLE DRINKING WATER
AS REQUIRED FOR TOTAL COLIFORMS**

Dear Mr. Diehl:

Your public water system is in violation of Rule 3745-81-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the coliform monitoring requirements. Eight special purpose bacteria samples were collected in October to try and determine where the bacteria is originating from. It appears that all three wells are free of bacteria and the source may be in the distribution system. Due to the ongoing investigation no routine samples were collected in October.

Monitoring Period:	October 2007
Required Coliform Sampling:	At least 5 <u>routine</u> samples in the month after a coliform-positive
Sample Results Submitted:	None
Actions required as a result of the above violation	
Step 1	<p>Within 30 days issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections; and 2. If necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons served by the public water system. <p>Note: Systems opting to include the required public notice in the next water bill have up to 90 days. <i>The language in italic on the attached public notice is mandatory language and must be included as written.</i></p>

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Step 2	Within ten (10) days of completing Step 1 above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the District Office of the Ohio EPA.
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If samples were taken, we have not received the results. Please forward a copy of the results to my attention. Late reporting is a reporting violation but if the sample was taken and a result obtained, you will not need to issue the attached public notice.
