Thank you for your response letters (received on January 19 and February 10, 2012) to Ohio EPA's January 5, 2012, Notice of Violation letter. The timely communication and actions by L & M Lawn and Garden Equipment to return to compliance are appreciated. You provided evidence of corrections related to:

1. **Used Oil Container Condition, OAC rule 3745-279-22(B)**: Oil contents were removed from leaking containers in poor condition.
2. **Used Oil Container Marking, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)**: Containers of used oil that were unmarked, have now been properly marked.
3. **Used Oil Releases, OAC rule 3745-279-22(D)**: Spills of used oil have now been cleaned up and the affected soils will be properly disposed to a permitted solid waste landfill.

My review shows you have adequately abated the violations discovered during my December 2, 2011, inspection visit at your facility.

I am enclosing some other guidance on used oil management requirements. A business may not burn used oil generated by another business, without it being tested first to determine it meets regulatory specifications under OAC rule 3745-279-11 for used oil fuel.
