Dear Mr. Jones:

On February 24 and 26, 2009, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at Hukill Environmental Services (Hukill), located at 7013 Krick Road, Bedford, Ohio. During the inspection I noted that two permitted hazardous waste storage tanks, T-57 and T-59, had become unfit for use and had been taken out of service. Hukill was cited in violation of Permit Condition D.7 for failing to place the tanks in closure when they were no longer usable.

On December 14, 2009, I received the closure certification documentation and on December 23, 2009, I conducted a post closure inspection of two permitted tanks. Based on the documentation submitted and the post-closure inspection, Hukill has abated the following violation noted in my March 11, 2009, NOV.

5. Permit Condition D.7(a) and (b). Response to spills and leaks.

If a tank system becomes unfit for continual use, the Permittee must close its tank system in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-55-97 and its closure plan.


Two permitted hazardous waste storage tanks have been taken out of service, Tank 57 and Tank 59. Permit condition D.7 (a) states, in part, that if a tank system becomes unfit for continued use, it must be taken out of service immediately. Unless the tank can be repaired and placed back into service, the Permittee must close its tank system in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-55-97 and its closure plan.

Please note that the completion of closure letter will come under separate cover.

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve your company from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
