Dear Mr. Saft:

I am writing this letter in response to a report of open burning at your facility on Glenn Highway, Cambridge. The report and pictures indicate that oil filters, plastics, cans, automobile parts, etc., are being open burned in barrels and on the ground behind your building.

On December 16, 2008, I investigated this complaint. There was no one on site at the time of my investigation. Evidence of the open burning was observed. On December 30, 2008, I spoke to a man who said he worked for you and explained to him that a business cannot open burn any materials for waste disposal purposes.

Open burning improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a maximum fine of up to \$25,000 per day per violation. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action will be taken against you. I am enclosing a pamphlet that explains Ohio's open burning rules for you. The remaining solid wastes need to be disposed of in a licensed landfill.
