Re: Henry County Landfill Return to Compliance

Dear Board of Commissioners:

In a letter dated April 13, 2012, Ohio EPA provided notice of violation occurring at Henry County Landfill (facility) located at L-622 Township Road 11, Malinta, Ohio. The violation was originally communicated to you during an exit conference following an inspection conducted on April 2, 2012. On April 6, 2012, Ohio EPA performed a follow-up inspection of the facility to determine compliance with Ohio's solid waste laws and regulations. As a result of the inspection, Ohio EPA determined owner/operator has abated the following violation:

Citation	Requirement	Action taken
OAC Rule 3745-27-19(F)	Inadequate Daily Cover	Applied 1,400 cubic yards of soil to cover exposed waste

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
