**NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

This letter confirms our conversation of May 1, 2012 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 9818 Perrill Road, Canal Winchester, Ohio, you have been open burning furniture, speakers and miscellaneous plastic materials. Additionally, this was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off the premises.

This letter is not a final action of Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
