Dear Resident:

I am writing this letter in response to complaints received by this office on August 11 and August 14, 2008. The complaints allege that you are open burning an old camper at your home on Morgan Fork Road, Waverly.

On August 21, 2008, I investigated this complaint. No one was at your home at the time of my investigation. I left a pamphlet that explains Ohio's open burning rules and my business card in your front door. Evidence of the open burning of wood, metal, insulation, and other waste materials was observed next to the camper. Plastics, furniture, clothing, demolition wastes, insulation, garbage, etc. cannot be open burned in Ohio.

Open burning improper waste material at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action may be taken against you.
