Dear Mr. Nichols:

I am writing this letter in response to a report from the Little Hocking Fire Department, received by this office on December 8, 2008. The report states that insulation, wood, plastics, and other solid wastes from an old trailer were being open burned on your property, Ohio Avenue, Belpre. Members of the fire department spoke to two men who were burning the old trailer. They told the fire department that they had been hired by you to dispose of the trailer.

On December 17, 2008, I inspected the burn site. Evidence of the open burning of wood, carpet, plastics, insulation, and other solid wastes was observed. The metal trailer frame was next to the burn area. It appeared that a bulldozer or other equipment had been used to clean up the burn site.

The open burning of plastics, demolition wastes, insulation, carpet, tires, etc., is not permitted in Ohio. Open burning of this type is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a maximum fine of up to \$25,000 per day per violation. All open burning in violation of the requirements specified in OAC rule 3745-19-04 must stop immediately. If you continue to open burn or allow other individuals to open burn improper waste materials at this location, legal action will be taken against you as the property owner.

I am requesting a written commitment from you to stop open burning in violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04 within 14 days of receipt of this letter. The Ohio EPA has the authority to seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or to decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by Ohio EPA at a later date.
