Dear Mr. Croskey:

Thank you for your March 27, 2012, response to Ohio EPA's March 20, 2012, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. The information you submitted included used oil management documentation. My review of the documentation submitted reveals that Durable Corporation (DC) has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation cited in the March 20, 2012, NOV.

The following is a summary of the violation cited in the March 20, 2012, NOV as a result of my March 7, 2012, inspection and your compliance with respect to it:

1. OAC Rule 3745-279-24: Off-Site Shipment:

Generators shall ensure that their used oil is transported only by transporters who have obtained an EPA identification number.

DC has been giving the used oil they generated to an employee who takes it to his brother to burn in his used oil furnace.

On March 27, 2012, DC submitted information regarding the management of used oil. DC has contacted Heartland Petroleum in Norwalk, Ohio, and they will be picking up your used oil. DC will document the date and number of 55-gallon drums removed for each shipment.

With this information, this violation has been abated.

As we were unaware that we could not allow individuals to recycle our used oil, we will cease this generally considered positive practice immediately. I have spoken with a local company who will now come and pick up our used oil and dispose of it. The local company is: Hartland Petroleum, 4376 St. Rt. 601, Norwalk, Ohio 44857. They are not on your list but have assured me they are licensed in Ohio to pick up used oil. Each time we call them to pick up the used oil we will document the date and number of 55 gal. drums removed.

If our new policy is not satisfactory please advise.
