Dear Mr. Fetters:

On June 21, 2007, the Ohio EPA received a response to a Notice of Violation dated June 1, 2007. This response included a receipt for: the disposal of the contents of five drums identified to contain used antifreeze, oils, the scrap recycling of drums, a parts cleaner solvent receipt and MSDS information. On July 6, 2007, analytical data and waste profile information was received for the characterization and disposal of removed contaminated soils. On July 13, 2007, you provided a non-hazardous waste manifest and photograph demonstrating the cleanup of the release area. Review of this information indicates that all violations have been abated.

It is also understood that lamps will be managed as a universal waste and that you have implemented a program to ensure proper management of aerosol can waste.
