RE: CERTIFIED WARNING FOR OPEN BURNING OF SOLID WASTE

Dear Mr. Yoder:

JEDER, Inc. is in violation of Ohio's air pollution regulations and needs to take prompt action.

Cease Burning: Immediately cease all burning for waste disposal purposes and inform this office of the alternative disposal method JEDER, Inc. has chosen by January 15, 2008.

On Tuesday, December 16, Dean Stoll of this office observed illegal burning at your property. During a conversation between Mr. Stoll and Mr. Paul Beachy, the owner of the Berlin Auction House, Mr. Stoll was informed that both JEDER, Inc. and the Berlin Auction House burn solid waste on the property. A copy of the photographs of the illegal burning are enclosed.

Please be advised that the burning of waste at JEDER, Inc. is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-19-03, which prohibits open burning for waste disposal purposes. Further, Section 3704.99, of the Ohio Revised Code, provides a penalty of up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for violating the Open Burning regulations. Each day's violation, after a conviction, constitutes a separate offense and will be subject to the penalties as mentioned above.

I trust that you will familiarize yourself with the Open Burning Standards with the enclosed fact sheet and make appropriate arrangements to dispose of, or recycle the waste generated by JEDER, Inc. A second violation will result in the referral of this matter to the Ohio EPA, Central Office for legal action.
