Thank you for your responses to my April 16, 2012, Notice of Violation letter. On May 11, Jamie Vogler emailed me photographic documentation of the actions that Stolle has taken to return to compliance. The photos show the new phone lists with the contact information for the emergency coordinator, a map showing where in your facility the contact information has been posted, the location of emergency equipment and photos of the properly labeled waste containers.

I have determined that the actions you have taken are adequate to demonstrate that you have abated the violations. Specifically, this letter returns you to compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-52-34(D)(5)(b) and 3745-52-34(C)(1)(b).
