Subject: Notice of Violation of failure to issue public education materials for lead action level exceedance

Dear Ms. McFarland:

A review of our records indicates that your public water system incurred a violation of rule 3745-81-85 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) for failure to distribute lead public education information on lead in drinking water to each person served by the Concord Care Center-Hartford water system by November 29, 2011. The delivery of public education material is required whenever a public water system exceeds the lead action level.

Please note that you are still required to distribute the lead public educational materials within 30 days of receipt of this letter and submit verification of distribution to this office not more than 10 days after distribution. Public education must be distributed every 12 months as long as the water system exceeds the lead action level.


Actions required as a result of the above violation

Step 1	Within 30 days issue the attached public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following method(s) to reach all persons served by the public water system: 1. Mail or other direct delivery to each customer; and 2. Any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons regularly served by the system.
Step 2	Fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued within 10 days to the Northeast District Office of the Ohio EPA.
Step 3	Within 30 days provide the appropriate lead exceedance public education as required by letter dated February 14, 2012. Submit a copy of the public education materials along with the verification form. DRINKING WATER NOTICE
Failure to Provide Public Education Materials for
Lead Exceedances in Concord Care Center-Hartford PWS water

We routinely monitor lead and copper levels in our drinking water. OAC 3745-81-85 requires that a community water system shall deliver public education materials to consumers within 60 days after the lead action level exceedance and every 12 months thereafter, as long as the system exceeds the lead action level. We failed to deliver the proper lead public education materials to all customers by November 29, 2011, as required.

What is being done?

We are still required to deliver public education materials on lead in drinking water to consumers by:

- a. Mail or hand deliver AND
- b. Continuous posting in conspicuous places throughout the area served

Tier 2: Unresolved Lead Public Education public noticing requirement

PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 2 VIOLATIONS

The owner or operator of a public water system with a Tier 2 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but **no later than 30 days** after the system learns of the violation. Public notice shall be repeated every 3 months as long as the violation or situation persists.
