NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Nastoff:

This confirms my conversation of May 21, 2012 with your employee wherein I advised him that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 750 River Street, Columbus, Ohio, you were open burning construction debris and pallets. Additionally, this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises. Also, this open burning was occurring within a restricted area.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
