Dear Ms. Shaffer:

Thank you for your March 30, 2012, response to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation letter dated March 2, 2012. Seneca Sheet Metal Company's (SSMC) response included a management plan on how you will properly evaluate spent paint booth filters in the future. SSMC also submitted information that states you will begin collecting fluorescent lamps, managing them as universal waste and then recycling them at Environmental Recycling in Bowling Green, Ohio. SMCC has abated all violations found during our February 28, 2012, inspection and cited in my March 2, 2012, Notice of Violation letter. Below you will find a summary of the violations:

1. Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

This violation is considered abated as SSMC has provided me with a plan stating that the paint booth filters will properly be evaluated before disposing of them in the future.

2. Spent Lamps, Universal Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

This violation is considered abated as SSMC provided a plan outlining that fluorescent lamps will be managed as universal waste in the future and properly recycled.
