Dear Mr. Fuqua:

This letter is to inform you that corrective actions have been completed for the parts washer located in your auto repair shop. On February 22, 2012, I visited the facility and observed that operator instructions are now posted alongside the parts washer. In addition, a material safety data sheet was provided for the parts washer solvent. There are no halogenated solvents present, thus the unit is not subject to 40 CFR, Part 63, Subpart T – National Emission Standards for Halogenated Solvent Cleaning.

The violations of OAC rule 3745-21-09(O)(5)(c) and 3745-21-09(O)(2)(d)(i) which were cited in the Notice of Violation dated December 28, 2011, have been resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
