On May 9, 2012, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Northeast District Office (NEDO), received the addendum to the 2011 Annual Post Closure Report for the Mount Eaton Landfill located at 8544 TR105 in Navarre, Ohio. The document is dated May 8, 2012 and was prepared by Mr. Joseph A. Balog.

The addendum was submitted in response to a May 3, 2012, Notice of Violation that was issued as a result of Ohio EPA's review of the 2011 Annual Post Closure Report, in which it was identified that the annual report submission did not include an itemized cost estimate for financial assurance, as required by OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(6)(c).

The submitted addendum contains an itemized post-closure cost estimate. The itemized post-closure cost estimate is given as \$1,435,554.00.

A detailed account of Ohio EPA's review of the itemized cost estimate for financial assurance will be sent to you in separate correspondence.
