Re: Return to Compliance letter for Notice of Violation (NOV) issued on April 18, 2011.

Dear Mr. Culler:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the above referenced facility on April 18, 2011. Ohio EPA inspected the facility on April 7, 2011. During the inspection it was noted that the permittee did not install, operate and maintain equipment to continuously monitor the temperature of the secondary combustion chamber for the burn off oven, emission unit N001, in accordance with Permit-To-Install (PTI) 03-17159 issued on December 12, 2006. In order to correct the violations, Ohio EPA requested Pentair Water to install equipment to monitor the temperature of the secondary combustion chamber and implement monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting in accordance with the PTI.

Pentair Water has satisfied the request by installing the temperature monitor. The violations cited in the April 18, 2011, letter have been resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
