**Notice of Violation**

Dear Mr. Kimerline:

This letter shall serve as follow-up to the inspection conducted on August 8, 2007, of the above referenced facility by this writer. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the compliance status of all air contaminant sources located there.

Under permit to install (PTI) 03-17134 in Section C. Monitoring and/or Recordkeeping Requirements, the company has failed to maintain the following records:

1. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain equipment to monitor the pressure drop across the baghouse while the emissions unit is in operation. The monitoring equipment shall be installed, calibrated, operated, and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, instructions, and operating manual(s). The permittee shall record the pressure drop across the baghouse on daily basis.
2. The permittee shall perform daily visible emission checks, when the emissions unit is in operation and when the weather conditions allow, for any abnormal (above the allowable) visible particulate emissions from the baghouse servicing this emissions unit. If visible particulate emissions are observed, the permittee shall note the following in the operation log:
  - a. the color of the visible emissions;
  - b. the cause of the visible emissions;
  - c. the total duration of the visible emission incident; and

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- d. corrective actions taken to correct the excess visible particulate emissions.
3. The permittee shall perform daily visible emission checks, when the emissions unit is in operation and when the weather conditions allow, for any visible emissions of fugitive dust from the hot aggregate elevator, vibrating screens, weigh hopper, the aggregate storage bins, the rotary drum and cold aggregate elevator/conveyor serving this emissions unit. If visible emissions are observed, the permittee shall note the following in the operation log:
- a. the location and color of the visible emissions;
  - b. the cause of the visible particulate emissions;
  - d. the total duration of any visible emissions incident; and
  - e. any corrective actions taken to minimize or eliminate the visible emissions.

The above monitoring and recordkeeping violations need to be corrected as expeditiously as possible. We request that the company begin maintaining these records starting September 1, 2007. A copy of these records for the month of September 2007 also is requested. This information should be submitted to this office by no later than October 8, 2007.

The submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make a decision on whether to pursue or decline such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
