Dear Mr. Sennish:

This letter shall serve as follow-up to the inspection conducted at the above-referenced facility on October 13<sup>th</sup>. The reason for the inspection was to determine the compliance status of the emission units that are operating at this facility with the rules and regulations of the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC).

Based on my observations during the inspection and subsequent communication with you, the findings of the inspection can be summarized as follows:

1. The second quarter deviation report was due on August 2, 2010. This report was submitted on August 5<sup>th</sup>. This is a violation of the reporting term in both the Permit to Install (PTI) and the Title V permit for the roadways (F001) and the landfill operations (F002/P901).
2. The paved roadways were watered from the scales to the gate at the time of the inspection. No visible emission observations were taken during the inspection to determine the compliance status. However, thirty minutes prior to the inspection, a lot of excess dirt was noticed on the public roadway. This continues to be an issue that will need to be formally addressed. A letter explaining what step(s) will be taken is necessary.
