Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 3, 2012, Tammy McConnell and I performed a compliance inspection of Centria to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on this inspection, hazardous waste violations were found and a notice of violation was sent to you on May 15, 2012. On May 24 and June 11, 2012, I received emails from you which included documentation photographs indicating that the following tank violations had been abated:

- i. Design and installation of new tank systems or components, OAC rule 3745-66-92(A);
- ii. Inspections, OAC rule 3745-66-95;
- iii. Containment and detection of releases, 3745-66-93.

Other Compliance Issues:

You stated in your email that Centria has replaced the supersack for the coating line solids (D007) with a 55-gallon drum to ensure that you do not exceed the 55 gallon limit for satellite accumulation.

You have now abated all violations cited from the May 3, 2012 inspection. If you have any questions, please call me at (740) 380-5278.
