Dear Ms. Mireles:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the above referenced facility on August 15, 2008. The NOV was issued to the OCLGPS for the failure to obtain the proper permit for the replacement of an engine. The company submitted a PTI application to request terms and conditions addressing the replacement of an engine on a landfill gas powered generator. The application was submitted in February of 2009 and the PTI was issued final on September 9, 2009. In addition, the OCLGPS submitted a revised Title V application in September of 2010 to reflect the PTI changes. The Ohio EPA issued the modified Title V permit on December 15, 2010.

The issuance of the Title V permit resolved the administrative violation, and returned the facility back into compliance. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
