Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is in regards to an August dust complaint investigation in Hancock County. In late July, 2009, Ohio EPA's Northwest District Office received a complaint of excessive dust in an area along County Route 140, Findlay. In investigating the complaint, E. Jay Murphy of this office inspected two sites on CR 140: Tawa Tree Services, Inc., at 8420 CR 140; and Findlay Warehousing Co. Inc, at 8556 CR 140.

Both facilities had recently used portable grinders at their sites, and Ohio EPA requested information on these grinders. Both facilities provided copies of GoGreen, LLC's (GoGreen) Ohio EPA Permit Fee Assessment Invoice, and indicated that they had used your permitted 640 hp portable grinder.

GoGreen's permit P0103930 requires submittal of an Intent to Relocate (ITR) a minimum of 30 days prior to relocation of the portable source. Ohio EPA has no record of an ITR submittal for either site in Findlay, in violation of OAC rule 3745-31-03(A)(1)(p) and permit condition [1.g)(1)].


The violation cited above indicates a possible lack of understanding of the GoGreen permit requirements. Please provide a plan for bringing GoGreen back into compliance with its permit, and a timetable for implementation of the compliance plan. The DAPC is requesting a written response by no later than November 30, 2009.

Please be advised that the submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make a decision whether to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
