The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the company's letter dated May 23, 2011, in response to the NOV issued to the company on April 27, 2011. The NOV was issued following inspections conducted on April 5, 18 and 19, 2011. GoGreen has satisfied the request(s) put forth in the NOV with the following:

0369002001:

P901 – Portable crusher and material handling operations: The Company addressed the requirement to maintain records for the material handling operations in regards to fugitive dust by submitting a copy of a new data sheet on which the required information will be recorded. In addition, the company submitted a permit application to address the addition of a new portable crusher.

0369002002:

P901 – Portable grinding and material handling operations: The Company addressed the requirement to maintain records for the material handling operations in regards to fugitive dust by submitting a copy of a new data sheet on which the required information will be recorded.

0369002003:

P901 – Portable shredder and material handling operations: The Company addressed the requirement to maintain records for the material handling operations in regards to fugitive dust by submitting a copy of a new data sheet on which the required information will be recorded.


