



This is the company's third emissions violation in two weeks. Ohio EPA remains concerned, given TCIMS's indication that it will be significantly reducing production operations at its Mansfield site, that this matter is not being given due attention. Recent sweeping and water efforts have been observed but have not been effective enough to prevent this situation from reoccurring. Also it is not believed that adequate control is being implemented early enough in the day to achieve compliance. Again, Ohio EPA will continue to closely monitor the situation. The company's written response to this letter is requested by June 16, 2009. It should be submitted to Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office and contain a compliance plan that will remedy and prevent any such future violations from occurring.

Please note that the submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make the decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
