Subject: April 25, 2007 **Notice of Violation (NOV)** resolution, High Priority Facility (HPF)

Dear Mr. Bastidas:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to Style Crest Enterprises, Inc. (Style Crest) on April 25, 2007 for emission violations from resin spray units R001 & R002 and gel coat spray unit R003. According to a response from the company dated May 7, 2007, Style Crest has provided training to all step shop employees on Title V permit and MACT limits and requirements and have begun prescheduling step repairs to be done at the beginning of the shift so this spray time is accounted for and hourly and daily emission limits are not exceeded. The company has also started measuring out resin and gel coat to be applied daily so that the 40 lbs OC/day limit cannot be exceeded. In addition, spraying is now done at an even rate (guns are pressure controlled) below the 8 lbs OC/hr limit and guns are rotated in the afternoon to avoid exceeding any emissions limitations per individual gun (emissions unit).

Style Crest did not report any emission deviations for the 1st quarter 2007 and the NWDO feels the company has provided an adequate compliance plan to avoid future emission violations.
