Thank you for your July 2, 2012 (dated June 28, 2012) response to Ohio EPA's June 22, 2012 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included statements regarding re-training of staff managing the hazardous waste; changes to hazardous waste management practices to better assure compliance; creation of a <90 day hazardous waste accumulation area log to track each container of hazardous waste being accumulated in the area; associated photographs illustrating changes; assignment of container accumulation area duties to a "leadership team" trained to properly inspect the area.

My review of this documentation reveals that Crown Food Packaging has now abated the violations discovered during the May 29, 2012 inspection as listed below.
