On June 7, 2012, I conducted a site visit of Plateau Truck Stop to determine the company's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations, as found in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code (ORC and OAC, respectively). I sent you Notice of Violation (NOV) letters on August 1, 2011, October 3, 2011 and January 23, 2012 specifying the violations observed during a complaint investigation on July 26, 2011.

Based on this site visit, Plateau Truck Stop has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the July 26, 2011 complaint investigation. During this site visit you stated that scrap tires and used oil contaminated soil was removed and disposed of at the Pike Sanitation Landfill by Sundown Tire.
