Thank you for your June 21, 2012 response to Ohio EPA's June 12, 2012, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included photographic documentation showing the new accumulation containers for your facility's spent fluorescent lamps, which will now be managed as universal waste. Your response also included a copy of the new Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for handling any spent fluorescent lamps that are generated at your facility.
