Dear Ms. Snyder:

On July 19, 2007, the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control issued a Notice of Violation to the previous owner of the facility (Deco-Plas). The company was exceeding their short-term organic compound (OC) emission limits for several coating booths. Deco-Plas submitted a PTI application to modify the OC limits in August of 2007 and the PTI was issued final on June 3, 2008. In addition, Deco-Plas submitted a revised Title V renewal application in March of 2009, to reflect the PTI changes. The Ohio EPA issued the final Title V renewal permit on November 10, 2009.

The issuance of the Title V permit resolved the emission violations, and returned the facility back into compliance. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
