Dear Mr. Lucas:

On November 13, 2008 I mailed you a notice for exceeding the action level for lead for the Medway Elementary School. In that letter I failed to include a due date for the corrosion control report. The due date will be June 1, 2009.

The corrosion control report is a required action that needs to be returned to the Ohio EPA regardless of subsequent water monitoring results. Water systems are required to have a corrective action in place to reduce the exposure to lead to consumers. If subsequent samples show that the lead action level is not exceeded for two consecutive six month monitoring periods, the requirement to install corrosion control measures can be suspended.

I have received the required information for the public notice requirement.
