Subject: Resolution of Notice of Violation (NOV-HPF) issued on June 4, 2007 to Kalmbach Feeds, Inc. (0388010049)

Dear Mr. Bishop:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the above referenced facility on June 4, 2007. The June letter was issued as a result of an inspection that occurred on November 9, 2006. Following a review of the facility's records at the time of the inspection, it was determined that Kalmbach Feeds, Inc. had failed to submit reports for B001, was not maintaining records in accordance with permit-to-install (PTI) 03-17002 for P010 and P011 and failed to submit permits-to-operate (PTOs) for P010 and P011.

On June 26, 2007, Kalmbach Feeds, Inc. submitted fuel certifications to address the reporting violations of B001. Then, on June 27, 2007, the company submitted PTOs for P010 and P011. In addition to the PTO applications, the company requested that the agency administratively modify PTI 03-17002, issued November 15, 2005, to reduce the pressure drop recordkeeping frequency for these units to resolve the violation. This modification request will not be addressed through an administrative modification but instead will be reflected in PTOs that have been recently processed for the emissions units. Review and issuance of these PTOs is pending at this time.

At this time, the matters outlined in the June 4, 2007, letter are resolved and require no further action.
