NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Ms. Reed:

This letter confirms a visit by the Hebron Fire Department to your property on June 18, 2012 wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 3272 Hebron Road (Lot # 3), Hebron, you were open burning the insulation off of copper wire. Additionally this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises and also within a restricted area.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
