Demolition at 820 Steiner Avenue, Kenton, Ohio

Dear Ms. Tice:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Northwest District Office (NWDO) received notification on June 23, 2011, for asbestos abatement and demolition at King Forge located at 820 Steiner Avenue, Kenton, Ohio. On August 17, 2011, Ohio EPA conducted an additional inspection of the King Forge site to determine compliance with U.S. EPA's National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for asbestos and Ohio's air pollution control regulations adopted under Chapter 3745-20 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Ohio EPA's inspection of the 820 Steiner Avenue property found the pile of metal on the west side of Area I contained friable roofing material and thus needed to be maintained wet. During Ohio EPA's site visit on August 17, 2011, this pile was dry and visible emissions were being discharged while National Salvage was working to move the metal.

This Notice of Violation letter is being issued for the following rule violation:

1. Violation of OAC Rule 3745-20-05(B) "Standard for asbestos waste handling," for discharging visible emissions to the outside air during the collection, processing, packaging, transporting, or deposition of any asbestos containing waste material.


NWDO is requesting the company submit written response to this letter by September 8, 2011, which includes confirmation of the company's understanding of the standards for asbestos waste handling.

Please be advised that this letter does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 3704.06.

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Ohio EPA will make a decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at (419) 373-3058.
