Thank you for your April 18, 2012, and May 2, 2012, responses to Ohio EPA's March 14, 2012, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). You submitted the following information:

April 18, 2012 – 9029 re-notification form, aqueous parts washer information including the Material Safety Data Sheet, information pertaining to your generator knowledge of waste evaluation of the aqueous parts washing solvent (based on Safety-Kleen's overall customer usage) and updated pick-up of aqueous parts washing solvent receipts.

May 2, 2012 – analytical from the sampling of your aqueous parts washing solvent indicating this material is a non-hazardous waste.

My review of this documentation reveals that Firestone has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the February 22, 2012, inspection as listed below:


