**RE: Request for scheduled maintenance at Haverhill Chemicals
(premise number 0773000080)**

Dear Mr. Soucy:

On June 18, 2012, the Portsmouth Local Air Agency ("PLAA") received Haverhill Chemicals' written request dated June 18, 2012, pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 3745-15-06(A)(3), for authorization to continue operation of the Phenol III Process Unit (emissions unit P012) during the shutdown of the catalytic oxidizer (Haverhill Chemicals ID CatOx-4230-L) controlling volatile organic compound emissions from this unit.

Based on the information that was submitted with your request, I hereby authorize the shutdown of the air pollution control equipment serving the Phenol III Process Unit while continuing to operate the source pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (A)(3) of OAC Rule 3745-15-06 for the purpose of conducting scheduled maintenance.

This authorization is subject to Haverhill Chemicals adherence to the scheduled maintenance program expressed in its June 18, 2012, letter. If there is any deviation from the expressed program, such deviation shall be reported immediately to PLAA so that this authorization may be re-evaluated. This authorization may be revoked at any time by written notice from PLAA should the situation no longer justify continued operation of the source.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of

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the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:

This authorization does not exempt Haverhill Chemicals of any liability for any violation of Ohio law and does not limit the Director's authority to take action pursuant to the provisions of OAC Rule 3745-15-06(C).

Please notify PLAA prior to beginning the maintenance event and again when the air pollution control equipment is in full operation immediately upon completion of the scheduled maintenance.
