Dear Mr. Slark:

On June 5, 2012, Ohio EPA conducted a complaint investigation of your automotive body shop and repair business in Jackson, Ohio in response to a complaint received by this office alleging that hazardous waste was being mismanaged by your company. You were present during the investigation.

No evidence of mismanagement of hazardous waste was observed. However, Ohio EPA found the following violations of Ohio's used oil and universal waste laws:

- (1) **OAC Rule 3745-279-22 (C), Used Oil Storage Requirements for Generators:**
(C) Containers of used oil must be labeled with the words "Used Oil";

Several one-gallon containers of used oil were unlabeled and stored in a corner of the garage. A 250-gallon tote of used oil was also not labeled. During the investigation, the used oil tote was labeled and the contents of the one-gallon containers were transferred into the tote. Therefore, this violation has now been abated. - (2) **OAC Rule 3745-273-14(E), Labeling/Marketing-Standards for Small Quantity Handlers of Universal Waste:** Each lamp or container must be marked with the words or phrases "Universal Waste-Lamps" or "Waste Lamps" or "Used Lamps."

Several boxes of spent fluorescent lamps stored by your company were not labeled. During the investigation, they were properly labeled. Therefore, this violation has now been abated. Information on how to manage universal waste spent lamps can be found at the following link:
