Dear Mr. Wood and Mr. Hauptmann:

Thank you for Mr. Hauptmann's responses received on June 19 and July 6, 2012 regarding Ohio EPA's May 31, 2012. Notice of Violation (NOV) letter to Cool Containers. Ohio EPA conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of Cool Containers on May 15, 2012. It was not until after the NOV letter was sent to Cool Containers that Ohio EPA was informed that all regulated activities at the site are conducted by Farrar Scientific on behalf of Cool Containers. As noted in Mr. Hauptmann's response received on June 19, 2012. Cool Containers and Farrar Scientific share space at 30765 State Route 7, Marietta. Cool Containers rents space from, and contracts with, Farrar Scientific for the cleaning of gauges and distillation of spent Vertrel on behalf of Cool Containers. Thus, Farrar Scientific is the generator of waste, and the May 31, 2012 NOV letter sent to Cool Containers should have gone to Farrar Scientific.

The documentation submitted by Mr. Hauptmann of Cool Containers on behalf of Farrar Scientific included a waste evaluation of spent Vertrel and spent Vertrel still bottoms generated by Farrar Scientific. The documentation also included an assurance that used oil generated by Farrar Scientific on behalf of Cool Containers will be sent to an approved used oil recycler and will no longer be sent to an offsite used oil burner.

The violations that Cool Containers were cited within Ohio EPA's May 31, 2012 letter will now be retracted by Ohio EPA and instead, have been attributed to Farrar Scientific in our database as well as explained in this letter. My review of the documentation

submitted by Cool Containers on June 19 and July 5, 2012 on behalf of Farrar Scientific reveals that all of Farrar Scientific's violations have now been abated.

Enclosed for your records is a revised Site Identification/Verification form for Farrar Scientific. The previous form for Cool Containers that was included in the original NOV letter sent to Cool Containers is no longer applicable and should be recycled or disposed of.
