Dear Mr. Wilson:

On May 24, 2010 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 8295 Bavaria Drive, Macedonia, to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit. Along with my observations from the inspection I have provided comments concerning the General Storm Water NPDES permit below:

General:

1. This site is a non-ferrous metal recycling company and the drainage consists of multiple storm sewers emptying into a stream along the western border of the property.
2. All operations are conducted inside of the building.
3. Loading and unloading of non-ferrous metals is conducted behind the building. This is conducted so that the metals are not exposed to precipitation.

Inspection Observations:

1. Several pieces of scrap metal were left at the base of the loading dock. Mr. Wilson informed me that these scraps were swept up at least every three days.
2. Drainage from the loading dock empties into adjacent storm drains.

Action Items

- Inspect storm sewers for a visible sheen of oil or other fluids from trucks.
- Include a brief description of monthly inspections in the SWPPP.
- Include annual training dates and verification that training was conducted with employees in the SWPPP.
