Dear Mr. Rossetti:

On September 18, 2008, this writer conducted an inspection of your facility for the purpose of determining compliance with the above referenced Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit. You accompanied me during the inspection.

Coverage for this permit was issued on November 27, 2007, prompted by your filing a Notice of Intent for coverage on November 19, 2007. Although your facility by definition is a regulated facility per SIC Code 3715, my review of your facility indicates you should qualify for a No Exposure Exemption. The following link will explain this process: <http://www.epa.gov/npdes/pubs/noxguide.pdf>. If you do fill out the No Exposure Certification it should accompanied by a Notice of Termination (NOT) of your storm water permit. The NOT can be found at our Web site at: <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/>. Both forms are to be sent to Ohio EPA, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, Attention Mike Joseph, Division of Surface Water.
