Dear Mr. Reinhart:

On May 31, 2011 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 6225 Camp Industrial Parkway, Solon, Ohio to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit referenced above. Along with my observations from the inspection I have provided comments concerning your permit below:

General:

1. This site is the location of International Paper, a company that mainly produces folding boxes.
2. The storm water on the site empties into trenches on the north and south sides of the property. These trenches then empty into the road ditch.

Inspection Observations:

1. While walking around the outside of the building I noticed a few areas of concern. On the south side of the building there were two uncovered dumpsters. I was told the company has intentions of shipping out these dumpsters in the near future. Should this not be the case, they should be covered by a tarp or lid to prevent water from collecting and leaching out.
2. Another dumpster was found on the north side of the facility containing waste paper product. Although this container was properly lined and covered, some red, cloudy liquid was spotted leaking from the container. This container was also located a few feet from a storm drain. To prevent any liquid from getting into the storm water system this dumpster should either be moved further away from the storm drain or frequently monitored for signs of leakage. If more leaking occurs, the source should be traced and replaced or removed.
3. There were slight traces of oil sheen on puddles located on the north side of the building. Make sure any trucks which are leaking oil use drip pans when parked and that any spills are cleaned up using good housekeeping techniques.


