Dear Mr. Smith:

On June 10, 2010 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 4457 Tallmadge Road in Rootstown, Ohio to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit referenced above. Along with my observations from the inspection I have provided comments concerning your SWPPP below:

General:

1. This site is the location of Jet Rubber Company, a manufacturing company specializing in custom molded rubber and rubber to metal components.
2. Drainage on the site is divided into two areas. Storm water from the parking area drains to the southern portion of the site into the roadside ditch along Tallmadge Road. Storm water from the area behind the building empties into a yard along the northern border of the property.
3. No production is conducted outdoors.

Inspection Observations:

1. There was no spill kit located in the truck loading/unloading dock.

Permit:

1. Records of employee training should be kept in the SWPPP.
2. Records of monthly monitoring should be kept in the SWPPP.
3. All records should be kept for at least 6 years from the date of origination as required in Part VI, C of the permit. These records should be kept on site as an appendix to the SWPPP.


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Action Items

- Keep a spill kit near the loading dock.
- Add employee training records to the SWPPP.
- Conduct monthly monitoring and include documentation in the SWPPP.
