Dear Ms. Carn:

On June 12, 2010 this writer conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 30701 Carter Street in Solon, to determine compliance with your Industrial General Storm Water NPDES permit referenced above. Along with our observations from the inspection we have provided comments concerning your Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) below:

General:

1. This site is a manufacturer of shampoo and conditioner products. Trucks deliver raw materials in bulk tankers and the final product is shipped out in commercial packaging.
2. There is outside storage at this facility with all of the tanks located within secondary containment. When rainwater collects in the diked area it is visually checked for contaminants then the valve is opened and allowed to drain to the rail ditch behind the property.
3. The main outfall for the site is located directly to the north of the bulk unloading area. This outfall has a shut off valve that is closed whenever trucks are unloading materials.

SWPPP:

1. Update site map to include location of current storage tanks and changes to any BMP on site.
